# History

# Equipment

·Calva: It is made of wood and it has the form of an obtuse angle. It has a length of 23 cm.



·Marro: it is an iron cylinder which weighs between 2 and 3 kilograms.



# Rules

- The aim is to knock down a piece of wood which is supported on one of its sides.
- The player must hit the *calva* with his marro from a distance of 14.5 metres. The player has 25 throws to achieve this, with two practice throws.
